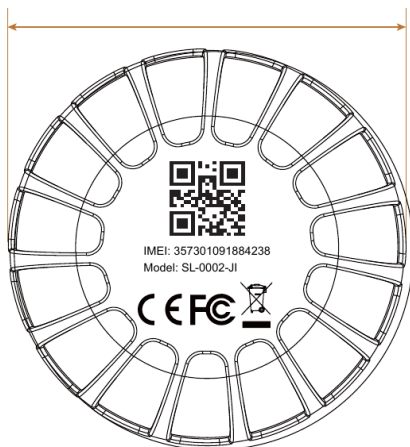

1 Introduction

The SL-0002-JI is a rugged, IP67-rated Bluetooth asset tag for locating and protecting plant, trailers, containers, tools and equipment. Its sealed screw-together housing and long-life replaceable cell make it suited to demanding outdoor and industrial environments, while the built-in buzzer supports audible close-range searching.

2 Product appearance

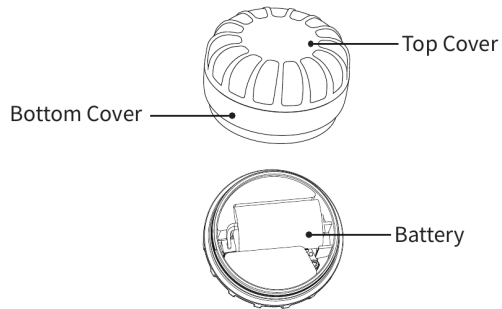


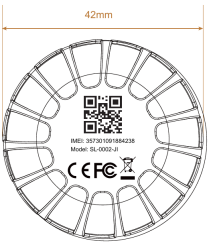
Figure 1 — SL-0002-JI component overview

The SL-0002-JI consists of a threaded top cover and bottom cover which seal against each other, enclosing the battery and electronics.

To open the device, rotate the top cover anticlockwise. To close it, rotate clockwise and tighten firmly.

3 Device identification

Each device is laser-marked on the base with its model number, unique IMEI and a QR code. Scanning the QR code returns the IMEI, which is the identifier used to provision and manage the device on the Vision Telematics Asset Tracking Platform.



Tip: Record the IMEI before installing the device in a position where the base is not easily accessible.

4 Specifications

5 Getting started

1. Hold the device and rotate the top cover **anticlockwise** to open it.
2. Insert the battery plug into the socket inside the device, observing the orientation shown. Once correctly connected the device begins operating and you will hear a beep.
3. Refit the covers and tighten them firmly. A fully tightened housing is required to achieve the stated IP67 rating.
4. Mount the device. For fixed installation, attach it to a flat surface using the supplied 3M™ foam adhesive pad by peeling off the release liner, or attach it to a metal surface using an optional magnetic mount. Select the accessory appropriate to the application.
5. Register the device. Scan the QR code on the base using the device management app to bind the tag, or contact Vision Telematics to have the device imported onto your platform account.

Note: Do not immerse the battery in water or expose it to fire. Do not damage or force open the battery. The battery is a primary (non-rechargeable) cell and must not be charged. Please recycle used batteries.

6 Important reminders

1. Battery life varies according to individual usage. Frequent use of the audible search function will accelerate battery consumption.
2. To maintain dust and water resistance, always tighten the top and bottom covers firmly after installation or battery replacement.
3. Because the device uses a crowdsourced Bluetooth location network, there may be a delay in positioning. If the management platform or app shows no data, wait approximately half an hour and refresh the location information. Where possible, activate the device in an area with a higher density of mobile devices.
4. Do not disassemble the device. Improper handling by non-qualified persons may damage the device and will invalidate the warranty.
5. Use only the battery type specified by Vision Telematics. Use of any other accessory or cell will invalidate all warranty services.
6. Vision Telematics accepts no warranty liability for damage caused by the use of non-specified accessories with this device.

7 Use and care

- Do not use the product in temperatures below -20°C or above $+60^{\circ}\text{C}$.
- Do not drop, disassemble, puncture, crush or expose the product to fire.
- Clean the product using a dry, soft cloth only.
- Remove and recycle the battery if the device is not to be used for an extended period.

8 Battery safety

WARNING — INGESTION HAZARD

- This product contains a button cell or coin battery.
- **Death or serious injury can occur if ingested.**
- A swallowed button cell or coin battery can cause internal chemical burns in as little as **2 hours**.
- **Keep new and used batteries out of the reach of children.**
- Seek immediate medical attention if a battery is suspected to have been swallowed or inserted inside any part of the body.
- Call a local poison control centre for treatment information.

- Use a CR14250 cell of the type specified by Vision Telematics.
- Non-rechargeable batteries must not be recharged.
- Do not force-discharge, recharge, disassemble, heat or incinerate the battery. Doing so may cause injury through venting, leakage or explosion resulting in chemical burns.
- Ensure the battery is connected correctly, observing polarity.
- Remove and immediately recycle or dispose of used batteries according to local regulations. Do not place batteries in household waste or incinerate them.
- Always secure the housing completely. If the housing cannot be closed securely, stop using the product, remove the battery and keep it away from children and animals.

9 Regulatory information

FCC compliance statement
